## LINCOLN WOMEN'S MUNICIPAL GOLF ASSOCIATION TEE OFF CLASSIC Pioneers Golf Course, Saturday, April 27 – 9:00 a.m. shotgun

- Teams: Players sign up individually. Using GHIN Handicap, teams are assigned an A player, a B player, a C player and a D player to balance the teams.
- Scoring: At completion of the round and after all scorecards are turned in, winners will be determined based on team scores. Scorecard playoff will break ties.
- Format: 18-hole Scramble tournament.
- Rules: 1. All team members will tee off on each hole. The team shall select the most desirable tee shot, mark the spot with a tee or ball marker. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within two club lengths (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. If a selected shot lies in a hazard, bunker, second cut of rough or fringe of the green, the ball must be placed within two club lengths of the selected shot, not nearer the hole and must be placed in the same condition, i.e., hazard, bunker or rough. Each member hits their next shot from the selected spot. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts.

2. The ball should also be marked on the putting green. Putts need to be within six inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). There are no gimmies.

3. Each team must use a minimum of one tee shot per member during the 18 holes. Make a note on the scorecard to indicate whose tee shot was used on each hole. If your team only has 3 players, that team may take a 4<sup>th</sup> shot at each ball. Before teeing off, decide the playing order and rotate taking each 4<sup>th</sup> shot in that same order throughout the round.

4. Tee off from the temporary yellow tees.

5. Each player has prepaid for two mulligans and may use them at any time during the round. A player is not required to use the shot made with their mulligan. Mulligans may not be transferred to another player to use.

6. USGA and local rules apply. Out of bounds are marked by white stakes. Penalty areas are marked by yellow or red stakes. There are many areas not marked around the course considered ground under repair caused by tee box construction, irrigation replacement, cart paths and tree removal.

## 7. Flag Contest:

#4 – Closest to pin 1<sup>st</sup> Shot

#7 – Longest putt made

- #10 Closest chip from off the green
- #16 Longest putt made
