PLEASE READ THE RULES CAREFULLY. DUE TO THE COVID-19 DHM AND USGA RECOMMENDATIONS THERE ARE SEVERAL CHANGES FROM OUR USUAL PROCEDURES

There will not be printed copies of the rules available at the course, so please print your own copy at home.

Tee Times: Please see Pairings List attached to this email and note your tee time. Since we have 40 players in this event (over the limit of 25 in the current DHM), please keep that in mind when planning your arrival time. When checking in at the golf course be mindful of the precautions in the club house – maintain 6 feet distance and wear a face covering.

Scoring: Your team will not be given a printed scorecard. Please use a golf course scorecard, list the team members names on the card and record your team score for each hole. At completion of the round, report to Donna May and verbally report your score and turn in your scorecard. After all teams have reported their scores, winners will be determined. Scorecard playoff will break ties.

- Rules:**
1. All team members will tee off on each hole. The team shall select the most desirable tee shot, mark the spot with a tee or ball marker. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. If a selected shot lies in a hazard, bunker, second cut of rough or fringe of the green, the ball must be placed within one club length of the selected shot, not nearer the hole and must be placed in the same condition, i.e., hazard, bunker or rough. Each member hits their next shot from the selected spot. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts.
 2. The ball should also be marked on the putting green. Putts need to be within six inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). There are no gimmies.
 3. **Each team must use a minimum of one tee shot per member during the 18 holes.** Make a note on the scorecard to indicate whose tee shot was used on each hole.
 4. Tee off from forward tees.
 5. Each player has two mulligans and may use them at any time during the round. A player is not required to use the shot made with their mulligan. Mulligans may not be transferred to another player to use.
 6. USGA and local rules apply. Out of bounds are marked by white stakes. Penalty areas are marked by yellow or red stakes.
 7. Flag Contest: There will be no flag contest this year.
